



# Sanitation Guidelines 2012

Latham Home Sanitation picks up City recycling Wednesdays. Recycling bins must be left at the curb by 7:00 a.m. Please call City Hall at (404) 294-5400 if you experience any problems with this service. Those reported after Latham has left the City will be dealt with the following week. There are bins available at City Hall for new residents. Items accepted for recycling are:

*It is not necessary to sort items.*

- All aluminum items
- All plastic containers (#1 - #7)
- All paper products
- Plastic bags
- All glass bottles and jars
- All cardboard items

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED: Any Styrofoam product      Any item contaminated by food waste

*NOTE: Please use caution when putting junk mail solicitations for pre-approved credit card applications, mortgages, or anything that has your personal identifiable information on it. It is recommended that you shred those types of items before discarding to avoid identity theft. ### Holiday Scheduling

#### Date of Holiday Observance

- Martin Luther King Day, Monday, January 16
- Memorial Day, Monday, May 28
- Independence Day, Wednesday, July 4
- Labor Day, Monday, September 3
- Thanksgiving holidays, Thursday, November 22 and Friday, November 23
- Christmas holidays, Monday, December 24 and Tuesday, December 25
- New Year's Day, Tuesday, January 1, 2013

#### Date of rescheduled pickup

- Tuesday, January 17
- Tuesday, May 29
- Thursday, July 5
- Tuesday, September 4
- Monday, November 26, regular pickup schedule
- Wednesday, December 26
- Wednesday, January 2, 2013

- ✓ Garbage and refuse containers should not exceed 32 gallons. All containers should be placed in one location with only the materials to be picked up in its proximity.
- ✓ Logs or tree limbs must be no longer than three (3) feet, and not more than four (4) inches in diameter, and stacked neatly at the curb. This material will be collected as rapidly as possible. **Trees, bushes, or other vegetation from commercial tree trimmers, landscapers, or building contractors will not be picked up by the City.**
- ✓ Debris will not be picked up from vacant lots unless a sanitation tax is paid to the city.
- ✓ Building materials, stumps, dirt, rocks, concrete products, automobile bodies and parts, tires, paint, oil and other liquids, and feces will **not** be picked up by the City. Return used tires to the dealer.
- ✓ Paint cans will be picked up only in 1 gallon containers. The cans must be filled with cat litter so there is no remaining liquid.
- ✓ Small dead animals (in plastic bags), appliances (take door off refrigerator), furniture, etc. must be placed at the curb and will be handled as special pickups by telephoning (404) 294-5400.
- ✓ Leaves must be kept separated from other yard debris for pick up at curbside by leaf vacuum equipment.
- ✓ The City participates in the county-wide recycling of Christmas trees. All tinsel must be removed.

You may transport normal home-generated refuse directly to DeKalb County Disposal Facilities. For locations, operating hours, and acceptable items at these facilities, call (404) 294-2900. For **hazardous waste disposal** information, call the Environmental Health Office 404-656-4713.
