RECYCLING

Latham Home Recycling Services picks-up the City recycling on Wednesdays. Recycling bins must be left at the curb by 7 a.m. Please contact City Hall through www.AvondaleEstates.org/requests if you experience any issues with this service. There are small bins available at City Hall for new residents and replacements.

Holiday Scheduling

Date of Holiday Observance

- Martin Luther King Day, Monday, January 18
- Memorial Day, Monday, May 31
- Independence Day, Monday, July 5
- Labor Day, Monday, September 6

- Thanksgiving holidays, November 25 and 26
- Christmas holidays: December 24 and 27

Date of rescheduled pickup

- Monday, November 29, regular pickup schedule
- Tuesday, December 28, regular schedule resumes
- Monday, January 3, regular schedule resumes

- ✓ Garbage and refuse containers should not exceed 32 gallons. All containers should be placed in one location with only the materials to be picked up in its proximity.
- ✓ Logs or tree limbs must be no longer than three (3) feet, and not more than four (4) inches in diameter and stacked neatly at the curb. This material will be collected as rapidly as possible. **Trees, bushes, or other vegetation from commercial tree trimmers, landscapers, or building contractors will not be picked up by the City.**
- ✓ Debris will not be picked up from vacant lots unless a sanitation tax is paid to the city.
- ✓ Building materials, stumps, dirt, rocks, concrete products, automobile bodies and parts, tires, paint, oil and other liquids, and feces will **not** be picked up by the City. Return used tires to the dealer.
- ✓ Paint cans are picked up only in gallon containers. Cans must be filled with cat litter so there is no remaining liquid.
- ✓ Small dead animals (in plastic bags), appliances (take door off refrigerator), furniture, etc. must be placed at the curb and will be handled as special pickups through the website at www.avondaleestates.org/requests.
- ✓ Leaves must be kept separate from other yard debris and other items) for pick up at curbside by leaf vacuum equipment.
- ✓ The City participates in the county-wide recycling of Christmas trees. All lights, stands, and decorations must be removed.

You may transport normal home-generated refuse directly to DeKalb County Disposal Facilities.
