WHEREAS, health officials have asked citizens, businesses, organizations, and
governments to take temporary measures to slow the spread of coronavirus; and

NOW, AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, public, in-person attendance at all
upcoming meetings will be prohibited indefinitely. All public meetings of City-related
boards, commissions, and committees, including the Board of Mayor and
Commissioners, will be available through virtual teleconferencing, as permitted by
Georgia law to protect public health. Interested parties will be allowed to participate in
the meeting via a teleconference number which will be announced prior to each
meeting on the City’s website, as well as through City e-news. Additionally, the City will
continue to operate a livestream of meetings on the City’s Facebook page until
otherwise noticed.

**RESOLUTION REGARDING TEMPORARY CHANGES IN SANITATION
COLLECTION PROCEDURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS
PANDEMIC**

WHEREAS, the coronavirus (COVID-19) has affected thousands of people worldwide;
and

WHEREAS, health officials have asked citizens, businesses, organizations, and
governments to take temporary measures to slow the spread of coronavirus; and

NOW, AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City believes it important to limit
contact between residents and City staff to the greatest practicable extent. Therefore,
the City will be suspending backdoor sanitation collection throughout the City
indefinitely. All residents and businesses are asked to move garbage containers to the
curb or designated enclosures on scheduled sanitation collection days and avoid face-
to-face contact with sanitation workers where possible. In instances where someone is
physically unable to perform these tasks, he or she may apply for a waiver using the
form located on the City's website. City staff also plans to distribute flyers and waiver
forms to all residents notifying them of the change.

**RESOLUTION REGARDING TEMPORARY CHANGES IN EMPLOYEE
COMPENSATION IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC**

WHEREAS, the coronavirus (COVID-19) has affected thousands of people worldwide;
and

WHEREAS, health officials have asked citizens, businesses, organizations, and
governments to take temporary measures to slow the spread of coronavirus; and

NOW, AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in the event a City employee is placed on
quarantine by a physician, the City will continue to provide him or her regular
compensation without interruption or exhaustion of sick leave balances. If an employee
is confirmed to have contracted the virus, the City Manager may determine that all non-
essential personnel should remain isolated at home to avoid further exposure to City
staff and residents; in this case, the affected employees will continue to receive regular
compensation without affecting sick leave balances.
