

**RESOLUTION REGARDING TEMPORARY PUBLIC MEETING POLICY
IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC**

WHEREAS, the coronavirus (COVID-19) has affected thousands of people worldwide;
and

WHEREAS, health officials have asked citizens, businesses, organizations, and
governments to take temporary measures to slow the spread of coronavirus; and

NOW, AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, public, in-person attendance at all
upcoming meetings will be prohibited indefinitely. All public meetings of City-related
boards, commissions, and committees, including the Board of Mayor and
Commissioners, will be available through virtual teleconferencing, as permitted by
Georgia law to protect public health. Interested parties will be allowed to participate in
the meeting via a teleconference number which will be announced prior to each
meeting on the City's website, as well as through City e-news. Additionally, the City will
continue to operate a livestream of meetings on the City's Facebook page until
otherwise noticed.
