

**RESOLUTION REGARDING TEMPORARY CHANGES IN SANITATION  
COLLECTION PROCEDURES IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS  
PANDEMIC**

**WHEREAS**, the coronavirus (COVID-19) has affected thousands of people worldwide;  
and

**WHEREAS**, health officials have asked citizens, businesses, organizations, and  
governments to take temporary measures to slow the spread of coronavirus; and

**NOW, AND THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City believes it important to limit  
contact between residents and City staff to the greatest practicable extent. Therefore,  
the City will be suspending backdoor sanitation collection throughout the City  
indefinitely. All residents and businesses are asked to move garbage containers to the  
curb or designated enclosures on scheduled sanitation collection days and avoid face-  
to-face contact with sanitation workers where possible. In instances where someone is  
physically unable to perform these tasks, he or she may apply for a waiver using the  
form located on the City's website. City staff also plans to distribute flyers and waiver  
forms to all residents notifying them of the change.
