**A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS
OF THE CITY OF AVONDALE ESTATES TO DECLARE THAT
EMERGENCY CONDITIONS CONTINUE TO EXIST WHICH
NECCESITATE MEETING BY ZOOM TELECONFERENCE.**

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2021, a City employee working at City Hall was confirmed positive for the virus known as Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager acted promptly to close City Hall to the public in order the minimize the likelihood of transmission of the virus; and

WHEREAS, there continues to be a prevalence of Covid-19 infections in the community and City Hall remains closed to the public in order to protect employees and residents from the transmission of Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Commissioners is authorized by O.C.G.A. Section 50-14-1(g) to meet via Zoom videoconference when emergency conditions exist that make it unsafe to meet in person.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Commissioners that the Board hereby finds that, in light of the prevalence of Covid-19 cases in the community, emergency conditions exist that necessitate holding meetings of the Board of Mayor and Commissioners by teleconference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public shall have simultaneous access to Board meetings via the Zoom videoconference platform.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall remain in effect until subsequent action of the Board to modify or repeal it.
