

- Item No. 3 **2018 Tax Millage Rate Ordinance – Second of Three Required Readings**  
The millage rate is a number set each year to calculate property taxes. A millage rate of 9.957 mills is proposed for 2018. Even though that is the current rate, taxes would rise 8.32% because of increased property values. For taxes to remain the same, a millage rate of 9.192 mills (called the “rollback”) would be set.  
  
This is the first of three readings before the Board of Mayor and Commissioners (BOMC) votes to set the millage rate. The vote takes place this same day at the regular meeting after the final public hearing at 6:30 p.m.
