

- Rear end (45%)
- Angle (35%)
- Sideswipe (20%)

Intersection Performance



- **20,200 vehicles daily**
- **70% Peak Hour is through traffic**

 - Urban design


Planning Themes

Recommendations from the Master Plan





The Project may include:

- Reduction of travel lanes
- Center turn lanes
- Wider sidewalks
- Bicycle lanes
- Planting strips for trees
- Rain gardens
- Lighting

Design Themes & Guiding Principles

- Bicyclists and pedestrians priority
- Safety for ALL users is critical
- More focus on intersection treatments
- Dedicated bike lanes where possible
- Consistent cross section/Connectivity
- Minimize right-of-way takings
- Consolidate/Quality bus stops
- Attractive design and streetscape
- Supports economic vitality




